ORDINANCE NO. 2005 - 14

**MAKING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBTITLE ONE OF TITLE 39
WITH VARIOUS TRAFFIC REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO THE
FARMERS AND MECHANICS BANK AND REGULATING THE USE OF
SAID ROADWAYS, STREETS, DRIVEWAYS AND PARKING LOTS BY
MOTOR VEHICLES**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council and the Farmers and Mechanics Bank of Riverton, New Jersey have entered into an agreement to provide for Borough residents to utilize the Bank's second parking lot located on Harrison Street, Block 1102, Lot 12.02, as evidenced by the agreement which is attached hereto,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF RIVERTON, COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY THAT:

Farmers and Mechanics Bank has filed a written consent with the Borough of Riverton that the provisions of Subtitle One of Title 39 of the revised statutes of New Jersey be made applicable to the semi-public roads, streets, driveways and parking lots at the Farmers & Mechanics Bank located in the Borough of Riverton, County of Burlington, and the following regulations shall be enforceable:

REGULATIONS:

1. General Parking
 - A. All vehicles must park in designated areas and between the lines provided.
 - B. No person shall park a vehicle for longer than the time limit upon any of the streets or parts of streets described below.

C. Handicapped Parking

All stalls shall be 12 foot wide as shown on the attached site plan and signed with the R7-8 and R7-8P (Reserved Parking Sign and Penalty Plate), in the designated parking areas for persons who have been issued the Handicapped Parking Permit by the Division of Motor Vehicles.

2. Reserved Parking:

All vehicles that are granted specialty parking in this section such as; police vehicles, ambulances, teachers, etc. must be properly identified and the reserved parking spaces must be shown on the attached site plan.

3. Tow-Away Zones:

Any vehicle parked or standing as to obstruct or impede a normal flow of traffic block entrances or exit ways, loading zones, oil fills, any grassy area pedestrian walkway, or present in any way a safety or traffic hazard may be removed by towing the vehicle at the owners or operators expense.

4. All signing shall conform to the current 2003 Edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-198 and N.J.S.A. 39:4-183.27.

Unless another penalty is expressly provided for by the New Jersey Statute, every person convicted of a violation of this ordinance or any supplement thereto shall be liable to a penalty of not more than (\$50.00) dollars or imprisonment for a term not exceeding fifteen (15) days or both.

5. Effect of Ordinance:

If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of the Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon immediate adoption.
