

BOND ORDINANCE AMENDING BOND ORDINANCE  
NUMBERED 6-05 OF THE BOROUGH OF RIVERTON, IN  
THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY FINALLY  
ADOPTED APRIL 13, 2005 IN ORDER TO INCLUDE THE  
2007 ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF  
RIVERTON, IN THE COUNTY OF BURLINGTON, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-  
thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3(b) of Bond Ordinance numbered 6-05 of the Borough  
of Riverton, finally adopted April 13, 2005, is hereby amended to include, in addition  
to the 2005 Road Improvement Program, the 2007 Road Improvement Program, in  
accordance with the plans and specifications on file with the Clerk, including all work  
and materials necessary or incidental thereto ("2007 Road Improvement program").

Section 2. This amending bond ordinance does not increase the  
appropriation or amount of obligations authorized by Bond Ordinance numbered 6-  
05. Since the amending ordinance does not require any additional down payment,  
no supplemental debt statement is required to be prepared.

Section 3. The capital budget of the Borough of Riverton is hereby  
amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any  
inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local  
Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital  
program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is  
on file with the Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 4. Bond ordinance numbered 6-05 is incorporated in its entirety into this amending bond ordinance, except to the extent that this amending bond ordinance revises the bond ordinance numbered 6-05. Any inconsistencies or conflicts that exist between the two bond ordinances should be resolved in favor this amending bond ordinance.

Section 5. This bond ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
