ORDINANCE NO. 2010 - 1

**ORDINANCE FOR THE BOROUGH OF RIVERTON AMENDING
CHAPTER 123-15 TO DESIGNATE FOUR-WAY STOP SIGN
INTERSECTIONS IN SCHEDULE IX, CHAPTER 123-31**

WHEREAS, the Borough's Public Safety Committee has investigated the feasibility of designating the intersections of Harrison Street & Thomas Avenue, Seventh Street & Thomas Avenue, and Midway & Thomas Avenue as four-way stops in the Borough of Riverton; and

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Committee believes that the above said designations are in the interest of public safety; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 4:39:4-8 (b)(1) permits the Municipality to designate any intersection as a stop intersection on streets under Municipal jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the above said intersections meet that criteria; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Engineer has provided the appropriate certification as to the designations after conducting the appropriate study, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 4:39:4-8(b)(3) (*attached hereto*),

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that Chapters 123-15 and 123-31 be amended and supplemented as follows:

I. §123-31 Schedule IX: Stop Intersections

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 123-15, the following described intersections are hereby designated as 4-way stop intersections:

STOP SIGN ON

Thomas Avenue

Thomas Avenue

Thomas Avenue

AT INTERSECTION OF

Harrison Street

Seventh Street

Midway

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that a "STOP AHEAD" sign be installed on the

northeasterly side of Thomas Avenue at its intersection with Eighth Street.

II. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance will take effect upon final adoption.
