**ORDINANCE NO. 2010-7**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 74, ARTICLE II TO REGULATE  
THE DISPOSAL OF TRASH AT THE RIVERTON PUBLIC WORKS  
GARAGE/SEWER TREATMENT PLANT AND TO INCREASE ALL  
FINES THROUGHOUT THE CHAPTER**

---

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Public Works has expressed a concern about the amount of trash which is being deposited at the Riverton Public Works Garage/Sewer Treatment Plant by non-residents, including contractors; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Riverton wish to regulate the disposal of trash at the Riverton Public Works Garage/Sewer Treatment Plant; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Riverton wish to provide for increases in the fines in order to deter the prohibited contact in Chapter 74.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** that Chapter 74, Article II, be amended and supplemented as follows:

1. **ARTICLE I  
Receptacles; Littering; Collection**

**§ 74-6. Violations and penalties.**

Any person who shall violate this Article or any of the terms or provisions thereof or who shall do any act or thing prohibited in this Article, shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay a fine not exceeding \$1,000.

2. **ARTICLE II  
Collection and Disposal by Borough**

**§ 74-9. Collection and disposal by Borough; Exceptions**

- B.**
- (7) Owners and occupants of premises within the Borough on which

trash is accumulated may dispose of their own trash at such designated area at the Riverton Public Works Garage/Sewer Treatment Plant in a manner consistent with this Article. It is unlawful for any other person to deposit trash at the Riverton Public Works Garage/Sewer Treatment Plant.

**§ 74-13. Violations and penalties.**

A. Any person who violates any provision of this Article shall be subject to a fine not exceeding \$1,000.

ARTICLE III  
**Yard Waste Collection**

**§ 74-17. Violations and penalties.**

A. Any person(s) who is found to be in violation of the provisions of this Article shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$1,000.

4.

ARTICLE IV  
**Litter Control**

**§ 74-22. Violations and penalties.**

A. Any person(s) who is found in violation of the provisions of this Article shall be subject to a fine not to exceed \$1,000.

5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage.
