2022 TRASH PROGRAM CHANGES

BEGINS ON MONDAY JANUARY 3, 2022

SERVICE NOTES

- Your new trash pickup day is **MONDAY** (no longer **Tuesday**)
- Pick-ups can begin at 6 o'clock a. m.
- Automated carts will be assigned and delivered to each property in the Borough. These carts will have a serial number that we can identify to the property.
- Start using your new cart on Monday, January 3, 2022.

CART SERVICE

- Ensure a minimum of 3 feet distance from cart to objects (i.e., parked cars, mailboxes, lamp posts, etc.)
- Cart handles should face the house.
- Only contents inside the carts will be collected. This means no refuse lying next to cart will be taken.
- Cart lids should be fully closed with nothing sticking out of the can.

ADDITIONAL CARTS FOR PURCHASE

- Each Residential property will receive a 96-gallon cart at no cost.
- After March 1, 2022 residents may purchase an additional cart at the Borough Hall (cash or check payable to the Borough of Riverton)
- Costs for additional carts: 32-gallon cart \$85 per cart / 64-gallon cart- \$95 per cart / 96-gallon cart- \$110 per cart
- Public Works will deliver pre-purchased carts to your property the following Friday. No cart deliveries Monday – Thursday. Carts may not be picked up at the DPW Yard by residents.
- If the 96-gallon is too big for your needs, smaller carts can be traded at no cost, please call.

WHAT TO DO WITH YOUR OLD GARBAGE CAN?

- You can dispose of your old can at the Riverton Public Works Yard at 820 3rd Street in a designated dumpster that will be marked for this purpose only.
- Only carts with a Borough logo will be recognized for *pick up*. Your old regular trash container cannot be used.

BULK COLLECTION SERVICE

- First Friday of each month.
- Bulky items should not exceed 75 lbs. and/or 6 feet.
- If an object does NOT fit into a cart it is bulk trash.
- This is not an additional garbage pick-up day; Bulky items only!
- Bulky items DO NOT include electronics, propane tanks, construction/contractor debris, concrete, etc. (Borough trucks will take your old appliances on Bulk pick-up days only)
