Some agenda items will include:

-Working on getting certified with <u>Sustainable Jersey</u>. We will be dedicating about 15 minutes of each meeting to getting our application in order. If we succeed in getting certified, we can qualify to earn some grants for Riverton through this program. We could use everyone's help putting the application together. Again, no experience necessary!

-Updates on the <u>Trex Challenge</u> (and how you can help!). The Trex challenge involves our collecting of flexible plastics, which we can then submit to qualify for a free bench made of recycled plastics. A small group of volunteers has been storing and dropping of the plastic as needed, but

we could use a few more hands to help with this task! Our basements can only hold so much.

-Updates on event planning related to topics such as composting and rain barrels. We'd love for more folks to help with this outreach!
