How did you first get involved with the Riverton Environmental Commission (EC) and/or Green Team?

When I moved to Riverton in the winter of 2023, national and global events inspired me to engage with the local community. I noticed EC/Green Team meetings listed on the borough's community calendar. Given my background in sustainability efforts through my career, I felt I could contribute to the town. I attended my first meeting in the summer of 2024 and have since become more active with the team.

What is your favorite natural spot or feature in Riverton?

I love walking, running, biking, and rollerblading along the Delaware. I often train by traveling circuits that take me from the Yacht Club to the Palmyra Nature Cove, and back.

What actions do you take at home to help the environment?

I am always striving to improve in this regard. I use reusable cleaning towels and mop heads instead of disposable paper towels and pads. Nearly all my cleaning supplies are now non-toxic and biodegradable, and I air dry my laundry whenever possible. I typically take public transit when traveling to NYC or Philly. This spring, my girlfriend and I are excited to start composting and planting native species in our flower beds.

What steps do you think anyone can take to be greener?

Some small wins include getting away from disposable water bottles, buying glass jarred grocery items instead of plastic, and using biodegradable pet waste bags!

What sustainability or environmental initiative have you seen other municipalities adopt that you think would be a great idea for Riverton to consider adopting or promoting?

I have visited Davis, California, a few times for work, and was very impressed with their cutting-edge sustainability initiatives. The city plans to be carbon neutral by 2040. To achieve this, they are switching all city work vehicles and transportation buses to EVs. The city also sort waste effectively, with composting and varied recycling options throughout the city. The town's college, UC Davis, will also be carbon neutral by 2025!
