What Have We Been Up To?

The Environmental Commission and Green Team, along with Council liaisons, have been listening to resident concerns and continue to research environmental issues such as pollution drift from Philadelphia and possible code violations at sites within the Borough.

The Environmental Commission and Green Team are exploring partnering with Burlington County and an engineering firm to conduct a climate change vulnerability assessment for Riverton. The goal is to identify key actions to help mitigate risks to the community.

We're also collaborating with the New Jersey Composting Council on developing a compost education and pilot program for Riverton residents—stay turned for more information about this soon!

We have been getting around! In the past few weeks, we set up info tables at food truck events and Juneteenth. Come say hi at the next food truck event on Wednesday, September 17, 2025. We'll be debuting a few handouts for the kiddos!

Finally, we kicked off our Climate Change reading group in July. Are you interested in reading more about climate change and learning about what you can do to help?
